

February 4, 2024











In January, Pastor Julia informed the Mission Committee about the Souper Bowl of Caring that was started by a Presbyterian youth group years ago and used in her previous churches. The idea was, as millions watched the Super Bowl, there were millions who didn't even have soup to eat. We approached Lark and Bliss Rippy, our only 2 potential youth group members, with the concept and they bought into it immediately. So, we asked them to chose from the 3 Mission partners who have food banks to be the recipient of any money raised. Then, label 3 soup pots, one for each Super Bowl team and one labeled "Game? What Game" so donors could vote for their team.....or NOT.

A few days later, our Marc Fors was delivering for Our Daily Bread and discovered that the steam kettle (equipment crucial to preparing the 175 meals they provide every day) was broken. Best guess was that it would take \$6000 for a substitute. Lark and Bliss chose Our Daily Bread be our recipient of any money raised.

The first count after church Sunday exceeded \$7000. We had been told by several members that more funds were to come and even had offers to make up any short fall.

Our Daily Bread could not find a substitute. It would take \$23,500 to replace the equipment. Calls were made, promises kept, the funds were raised, the equipment will be replaced!!

Thanks to Lark and Bliss and Christ Church LBK. Oh yeah, the 49ers' pot had the most \$ raised with Chiefs and "Game. What Game?" close behind.

"One Great Hour of Sharing" **Special Offering March 24**

In March of 1949--75 years ago this month--a special national radio program was broadcast on a Saturday evening, calling on all Christians to go to worship the next day and share in **One Great Hour** of ecumenical generosity for relief in war-torn regions of the world. The program began with an address by then-President Harry S. Truman and included celebrities such as Gregory Peck. Agnes Moorehead and Glenn Ford.

The offering became known as One Great Hour of Sharing and is still received annually by several American denominations. Its purpose remains essentially the same: to provide (1) relief from disaster, (2) food for the hungry, and (3) development opportunities for the poor and oppressed. In the PC(USA), the offering is divided equally between the Presbyterian Hunger Program, Presbyterian Disaster Assistance, and Self-Development of People. Each program meets needs both within and beyond the United States.


